B. PRACTICAL /CLINICAL

*One term of three months each in out-patient department and in-patient department respectively for Case Taking , analysis, evaluation and provisional prescription for case presentation on **ten cases per month.***

* Each student has to maintain records of **20 worked out cases (10 chronic and 10 acute)**.

The case records should stress following :

- 1) Case taking ,
- 2) Nosological Diagnosis
- 3) Analysis of symptoms ,
- 4) General management including diet and regimen, Prognosis, Miasmatic diagnosis,
- 5) State of Susceptibility
- 6) Evaluation of symptoms portraying Totality of Symptoms
- 7) Remedy Selection and Posology
- 8) Second Prescription

- Each student shall present at least **01 case** in the departmental Symposium/Seminar
