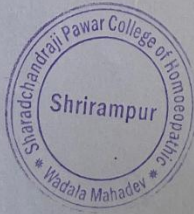




5. The College has to develop the requisite infrastructure and specific requirements to conduct IVth Professional BHMS course and also to get permission for the session 2018-19.





I am directed to refer the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC (MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC (MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fail to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of Sharadchandraji Pawar Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital,, At Shiva Trust Campus, Gut. No 6, Wadala - Mahadev, Tal. Shrirampur, District - Ahmednagar - 413739, Maharashtra on 27.07.2018 and furnished the report of inspection of CCH and recommendation to the Ministry for the A.Y. 2018-19.

3. After considering the provisions of HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, inspection report of CCH, observation of the Hearing Committee and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2018-19, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Sharadchandraji Pawar Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital,, At Shiva Trust Campus, Gut. No 6, Wadala - Mahadev, Tal. Shrirampur, District - Ahmednagar - 413739, Maharashtra for continuing admissions in BHMS course with hundred (100) seats for the academic session 2018-19 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following

requirements by 31st December, 2018 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2019-20: -

- i. all the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013" by 31st December 2018 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31st December, 2018, shall be denied permission from academic year 2019-20 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and
 - ii. all the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
 4. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by December, 2018 and submit a compliance report to CCH under intimation to this Ministry for continuing admissions during the subsequent academic year. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2019-20 and furnish the recommendations to the Central Government.

2. 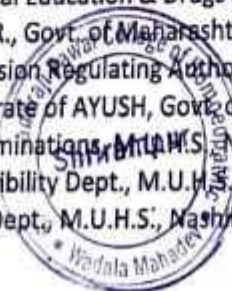

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats of Sharad Chandraji Pawar Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Ahmdnagar (M.S.), and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F. No. 15-8/2020-CCH/ (Visitation Matter)/3066 dated 12.10.2020 as under:-

"Recommended for allowing admission in 1-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 100 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course.

The Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry that the college does not have functional website and has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

The Committee further recommended to apprise the Ministry that the Physiology Dept. of the college does not have any eligible teacher due to discrepancies in their documents. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:

- 1. Dr. Dhubhangi Yashwant Kedar (Lecturer Anatomy) - Ineligible as discrepancy found in the provided documents for teacher's code - Date of appointment & joining mentioned in the documents as 01-09-2019, but in the experience letter mentioned experience from 01-10-2018.*
- 2. Dr. Abhay Arjun (Reader — Physiology) - Ineligible as discrepancy found in the provided documents for teacher's code - Date of appointment & Joining mentioned in the documents 10-10-2016, but in the experience letter mentioned experience from 01-10-2015.*
- 3. Dr. Sarika Laxmanrao Khandekar (Lecturer Physiology) - Age exceeded 40 year (Date of birth — 12-12-1976) at the time of Joining (Date of joining 15-02-2020) as Lecturer. 12-12-1976) at the time*

of Joining (Date of joining 15-02-2020) as Lecturer."

2. The college was granted an opportunity of hearing through Video-Conferencing to present their case on 29.10.2020. The college authority submitted the compliance report.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, and report of the designated Hearing Committee of this Ministry, conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Sharad Chandraji Pawar Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Ahmdnagar (M.S.) for continuing admissions in BHMS course with intake capacity of hundred (100) seats during the academic year 2020-21, with the condition to fulfil all deficiencies as reflected at para 1 within 31st December, 2020 from date of issue of this letter.

Maharashtra- 413739 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 23-24. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARB has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standard Requirements as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020, as per section 29 and subsection (3) of the Act.

As per the observations made by MARB, following information are provided for immediate rectification of the shortfalls. College shall fulfil all functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard Requirements as mentioned below:-

- Copy of Form-16 of the faculties from traces portal shall be submitted for verification.
- Copy of IPD case registers are not submitted in the part-I for verification.
- Case records are not submitted against the direction issued from MARB. IPD and OPD case records (copy of one OP and one IP cases of 1st and last day of every month) shall be submitted for verification.
- Case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as name, age sex, address, phone number etc.
- Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case analysis and evaluation and repertorisation and made available in medical record room for academic purpose of students.
- Lab investigation report should be maintained properly in case records.
- All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records.
- Disease diagnosis shall be recorded in all case records as per ICD 11 criteria.

All the shortfalls observed in your College shall be rectified within a period of 30 days or before counselling initiates, whichever earlier and compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB, failing which the conditional permission issued will be cancelled without further notice.

Considering the above observations, and facilities available, MARB has decided to issue conditional permission to Sharadchandraji Pawar Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, At Shiva Trust Campus, Wadala-Mahadev, Tq. Shirampur Distt. Ahmednagar. Maharashtra- 413739 for conducting BHMS course for the academic year 2023- 24 with intake capacity of 100 seats.

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the central govt for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
